Classic Tractor Pull Rules

1. Tractors must be registered and weighed to pull.
2. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times.
3. Only one driver per tractor per class.
4. The driver must start with a tight chain and at the starting signal from the flag man.
5. A hand throttle must control speed only.
6. Drivers must remain on the seat and maintain full control of the tractor during pull.
7. Tractors losing weight or other objects while hooked to the sled will be disqualified.
8. Tractors must stay within the pull boundaries.
9. If a puller fails to pass the 50' mark, one restart will be allowed.
10. Tractors must stop at the red flag signal from the flagman.
11. All decisions of the pulling committee are final. Any arguments will result in automatic disqualification.
12. Any driver under 18 years old must have written consent from a parent or guardian with supervision present.

Classic Class

Tractors must be model year 1966 – 1989. Tractors must be wheel driven by two wheels only. Tractors must have a stock fuel pump. Hood and grill must be in place and have a stock appearance.

Inspection

Tractors will be inspected during registration and weigh-in by the pull committee. Any tractor found to be unsafe or in violation of the rules will not be allowed to pull.

Drawbar

All tractors must have a hitch in fixed position, MAX 20" height and minimum 24" from center of axle to hitch. Use of a flat plate with a 3 inch hole or twisted clevis only.

Weights

May add weight to make class. Weight brackets must be bolted on. Weight must be securely fastened.

Tires and Rims

No cut tires, no aluminum rims, no duals, tracks or four wheel drive. 2 tire sizes over stock will be allowed.

Any tractors not conforming to these rules may pull in an Open Class.
